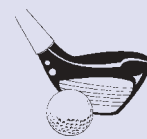


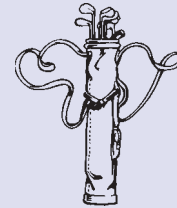


NHDA Annual Golf Outing

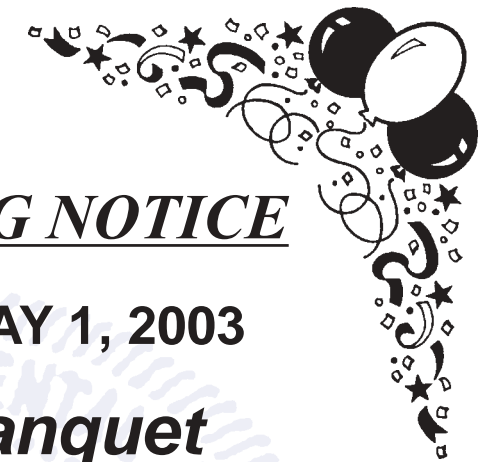
